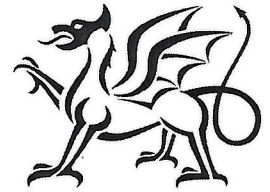

Thank you for your email of 9 August, regarding correspondence from your constituent Richard Bramhall, relating to the Marine Licence for deposit of sediment from Hinkley Point.

Following a debate on 23 May in the National Assembly for Wales on the Petitions Committee report on this matter, I note all the tests and assessments carried out by Natural Resources Wales (NRW), and their experts in this specific field, concluded the material is within safe limits and poses no radiological risk to human health or the environment.

This is a 'live' licence and as such it is a matter for NRW, who are the licensing authority, and your constituent's concerns should continue to be addressed to them.
